

## **Shore Regional Little League All-Star Players and Coaches Selection Process**



(Effective 2023 season)

## **SECTION 4 – Tournament Selection**

All players will be eligible to be selected to the SRLL All-Star team for their respective Division provided they meet the following criteria: Eligibility\*, Availability, and Ability. (\*NOTE: Eligibility refers to: Age, Participation in 60% of the regular season games (as of the date the Tournament Teams are announced) in that division, and Residence). Players MUST attend the Spring Evaluation Clinic to be eligible for a tournament or All-star team.

- A. The AA (aka Minors) through the Seniors teams (if applicable at the respective levels) will consist of up to 14 players that will be selected using the following system:
  - 1. Manager The Manager of the all-star teams will be selected by utilizing an application process. Any regular season head coach can apply to be the manager by filling out an on-line document. The application process will be open throughout the regular season and will close before the playoffs begin.

The Coaches Coordinator shall review manager applications with the League President, then present them to the head coaches of each respective division for a vote. The head coach who receives the most votes will be selected as the All-star Team Manager. In the event of a tie the League President and Coaches Coordinator will cast one vote to break the tie and make the final selection.

- 2. Player Selection Each Manager of AA through Senior Division level teams will select 6 players from their current roster (that meet the criteria) to enter into a pool of players. The managers of those respective divisions will then vote on their top 10 players from the pool to make the team. The All-Star team Manager then has the authority to select additional Players that will also be added to the All-Star team roster bringing it to the maximum roster size determined by the SRLL Board. The additional players must be selected from the pool of players who received the highest number of votes that have not yet been added to the team. In the event of a tie that produces more than 10 players the League President, Player Agent and All-star team manager will make the final decision.
- 3. Coaches The Manager of the All-Star Teams for the AAA through Senior Divisions will have the authority to select their own Coaches and may name up to 2 Coaches to serve as assistants on their teams. The candidates that can be selected must be a Head or Assistant Coach at the same respective level of the kids on the team (Majors, AAA, etc.).



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B. A Minors Division All-Star Team – The A Minors Division will host a 1 game intra-league All-Star game at the conclusion of the regular season. The teams (herein referred to as Teams "A" and "B") will be selected as follows:

- 1. Team Composition Team "A" will be comprised of Players from the teams that finished in 1st, 3rd, and 5th place respectively in the regular season standings. Team "B" will be comprised of players from the teams that finished in 2nd, 4th, and 6th place.
- 2. Managers All Head Coaches shall participate in the All-Star Game and shall be assigned to Team "A" or Team "B" respective to the regular season standings. In the event a Head Coach cannot participate, he/she will select an Assistant Coach of their regular season team to participate.
- 3. Players Each team will be comprised of 12 15 players. Each regular season Manager will nominate up to 2-5 players from their respective team to play on the All-Star Team. The Managers of the respective All-Star teams together will then be able to select the balance of their roster from the remaining pool of players available to them. In no instance will there be less than 2 players or more than 5 players from any one regular season team on the All-Star roster. The final team selection must be approved by the League President and/or Player Agent.
